Lindsey used the Career Center to work on her resume, take budgeting classes, and anger management classes. In just a short time, Lindsey settled into a job at Community Bakery where she still works today and has been promoted twice! With the help of recovery meetings and therapy sessions, Lindsey is almost two years sober. When she felt comfortable in her sobriety, Lindsey happily brought her daughter, Kaylee, to live with her again. Kaylee saw one of our Children's Therapists and enrolled in our after-school program, Our Club, which was a great help to Lindsey's work schedule. After 18 months in the Housing programs, Lindsey purchased a car and just secured her own apartment!
