Spotlight: Mandy

After being in unstable, abusive relationships for more than 20 years, Mandy decided to, in her words, "stop looking for Mr. Right, and start being Ms. Right." But life as a single mother in Hot Springs was difficult, and after falling behind on rent, she received an eviction notice that ultimately led her to Our House. Mandy and her two sons, Isaac and Daniel, moved into our Family Housing program last year. "My first priority was to get the children in school and catch up on medical care," Mandy recalls. With help from her case manager, Kate, and our on-site health clinics for both children and adults, she was able to do just that. The whole family also began seeing our mental health team to process their years of difficult experiences. With an uneven job history and a physical disability limiting her options, Mandy joined our job training program, working as a gatekeeper while searching for the right long-term job. Mandy's family is thriving with structure and stability—Isaac and Daniel are doing well in school and attend Our Club, while Mandy is working toward steady employment and completing her high school diploma.
