Our House Campus

Since 1987, Our House has grown from a 40 bed shelter to a 6 acre campus, to serving more than 400 clients daily. In efforts to maintain our beautiful, welcoming, and safe campus, our facilities operations crew mows, weed-eats, etc. Our House is located at **302 E Roosevelt Rd.** The Operations Support VISTA coordinates between the Campus Impact (CIVs), Our House staff, and other national service members.



The Role of a Campus Impact Volunteer

As a Campus Impact Volunteer (CIV), you will be working directly with our staff and national service members to help enhance and maintain the Our House campus.

Description of Tasks

- Perform ground-keeping and building maintenance duties
- Mow lawn, either by push mower or using riding lawnmower
- Landscape by planting flowers, grass, shrubs, and bushes
- Trim shrubs and pull weeds
- Water plants and grass as needed and apply fertilizer
- Rake, mulch, and prune the grounds as needed
- Perform minor repairs and maintenance procedures on equipment utilized in grounds-keeping
- Shovel snow from walkways and sprinkle ice down to keep people from falling
