The Role of a Workforce Development Volunteer

As a Workforce Development Volunteer (WDV), you will be working directly with our adult clients to help them achieve their goals and assisting the office team with any administrative duties.

Description of Tasks

- GED Prep: seeking volunteers with knowledge of English and mathematics
- Job Skills/Job Club training: interpersonal communication, being an asset, improving workplace productivity, etc.
- Financial literacy skill development
- Basic computer skills development: setting up an email, researching online job bulletin boards, etc.
- Mock interviews: helping clients “sell” themselves to potential employers, how to talk about past employment, answering common interview questions
- Resume reviews and consultations
